

**ERINDI IN HERERO MEANS "PLACE OF WATER".** Erindi Private Game Reserve is unique in southern Africa and perhaps even in the world. Reclaimed as part of a massive rehabilitation and conservation venture, the 161,058± acre reserve is a treasure chest of naturally occurring Namibian wildlife and plant life. Systems instituted almost two decades ago have ensured the recovery of the ecological balance between vegetation, herbivores and predators, while careful management ensures the numbers and diversity of species leads to sustainable land utilization and benefits for all in the area. Pathways wind through the camp and across soft green lawns between 48 luxury suites tucked away under indigenous trees. Old Traders Lodge is the perfect base for forays into the exhilarating bush, from spacious suites that offer charm, comfort and convenience. The ranch offers 621 miles of roads, 97 miles of solar fencing and a 5,577-foot gravel airstrip for easy access. Hosea Kutako International Airport is 29.8 miles from the capital city of Windhoek. Far enough away from urbanisation for its wildlife and plant life to thrive, it's still close enough for most logistics not be a problem, and for access to vital services.
